row, but the Blessed God shall come down teaching that his death shall bring to the despairing rest.

So, here is a summary of God's plan of

redemption, hidden in a genealogy in

Genesis! What is the probability of this happening by random chance? For each name there would have been hundreds of choices, but let's assume there were only 100 for each, giving  $(10^2 \times 10^2)^{10} = 10^{20}$  possible combinations. Then having chosen 10 names, the total number of ways to order them is  $10 \times 9 \times 8 \times 7 \times 6 \times 5 \times 4 \times 3 \times 2 = 3.6 \times 10^6$ . So, the probability of pick-

ing by chance that set of names in that

order would be 1 in  $3.6 \times 10^{26}$ .

That would be **very much less likely** than covering the earth with quarters one mile deep, with only one marked and located at random. Then with no idea were the marked one was, picking it by chance on the first try.

Who but God could have done this **thousands** of years ago?

This is a remarkable demonstration that God is in control of the world and history, and furthermore the Bible contains many additional equally remarkable "coincidences". This clearly demonstrates that the Bible is the Word of God, and can you afford to ignore it?
